

# Public Dharma Talk at Mangalam Centers, Berkeley



*Venerable Prasert Masoom (Ithiyano Bhikku) was born and raised in Pisanulok, Thailand. He earned a double B.A. degree in Law from Dharmasart University and in Political Sciences from Ramkhamhaeng Univeristy. Later he received an M.A. degree in Public Administration from University of Sydney, Australia. At the age of 53, Venerable Prasert was ordained as a monk at Wat Phra Bodhisatava in Saraburi. Within five years he returned to Wat Bua Luang, in Pisanulok, his home town where he is currently the Abbot. In 2003 upon the invitation from the Thai community in the greater Los Angeles area he later established Wat Phra-That Bua-Luang Thai Meditation Center in Tehachapi, California, where he is currently also the Abbot.*

*Venerable Prasert or Luang Por Prasert is well known for his skills and knowledge in Thai and Chinese traditional healing, utilizing medicinal herbs and plants for treatment combined with meditation practice and Luang Por's energetic transmission.*
